



# SOUTHEND HIGH SCHOOL FOR GIRLS

As a Sixth Form student, you are an ambassador for SHSG both in school, and in the local and wider community. It is therefore important that you present yourself in a professional manner at all times. An essential element of this is the school uniform.

The school uniform is compulsory for all SHSG Sixth Form students. Our students are expected to wear the correct school uniform both in school, and on their journeys to and from school.

The SHSG Sixth Form uniform is detailed below. Items in **bold** must be purchased from the SHSG school-wear outfitters. A list of SHSG outfitters can be found on the school website.

## Female and Male Uniform

**Green Blazer with SHSG emblem** - to be worn at all times in the main school

Plain, collared white shirt (short or long sleeved) with **green SHSG tie with emblem** or **SHSG white open-collared blouse**. All shirts must be tucked in.

Black, tailored full-length trousers or **black SHSG pleated skirt**. No jeans, leggings or cropped trousers.

**Plain, black V-neck jumper.**

Plain, black socks or plain black/natural tights.

Black, smart shoes with heel no higher than 5cm. No trainers or boots.

*Jewellery* – Only studs are permitted to be worn in ears. Other facial piercings are not permitted.

*Tattoos* – Visible tattoos are not permitted.

*Hair* – Natural colour hair. No extremes of colour or style.

*Outdoor wear* – No hoodies or sportswear permitted inside the school. Coats, hats, gloves and scarves may not be worn in school at any time.

*Make-up* – Natural make-up which must be appropriate for a professional environment.

*Sportswear* – You may wear any suitable clothing while participating in school sporting activities.

*Hijab* – Students of Muslim faith may wear a black or green hijab. No other head wear is permitted.

As fashions change, if there could be any doubt about the acceptability of a lasting change you are considering, you must consult the Director of Sixth Form or Head of Year before going ahead.

Students not presenting themselves in the correct uniform will have to change or remove items. Students will be asked to return home to change into the correct uniform.

The interpretations of the Senior Leadership Team are binding in all matters of uniform suitability.

If there is a reason why the correct uniform cannot be worn, permission for this must be requested during a parental meeting with the Head Teacher.
