## **Attendance and Punctuality**

As we head into a new year, we want to take the opportunity to remind parents about the importance of attendance and punctuality to school. The vast majority of our students have an excellent attendance record and the school's total attendance is well above national and local rates. It is well known that attendance has a significant impact on student progress and the school expects all pupils to attend every day and to arrive on time. Please note that requests for leave of absence during term time will not be authorised unless there are exceptional circumstances.











The DfE categorises attendance below 90% as persistently absent. To ensure the highest levels of attendance for our school community, when a pupil is in danger of becoming persistently absent, parent/carers will receive a letter informing them of their child's current level of attendance. Targets are then set during a 6-week monitoring period. Should there not be a significant improvement during that time, parent/carers are invited to the school for a supportive meeting, often involving the Local Authority's Attendance Officer, to discuss how we can work together to improve the student's attendance.

We understand that from time to time that students will fall ill; however, please remember that your child should only be kept at home if it is necessary. If you are concerned about your child's level of attendance, please get in touch with their Pastoral Support Officer.
