Year 12 A Level Computer Science talk

On Monday, a computer science class had a talk with a Solutions Architect from Amazon Web Services. She spoke to the class about her current role and the path that she took to get there as a woman of colour. It was interesting to learn about her journey from a business career to one in technology, as well as how the work she does at Amazon differs from our initial expectations. Particularly, it was fascinating to find out about how she uses a range of skills from delivering presentations to organising a team – students learnt that the skills needed in computing were not only limited to programming. Students were able to ask questions they had about the industry and gain insightful knowledge for future prospects.




Congratulations to Year 11 media studies students

Last week, SHSG Music Department held a battle of the bands gig on the main stage in the hall. Two student bands from Years 10-12 performed short but lively sets of rock songs, ranging from Arctic Monkeys to Avril Lavigne. The younger band *Delta* went first, with strong rhythm section and punk vocal chants, followed by the senior band *They Might Be After Us*, who had an energetic set combined with powerful lead vocals.

Congratulations to Freya, from 7 Hera, for winning this year's competition with an excellent vocal performance of *Out Here On My Own*, from the musical *Fame*. This wowed the audience and was chosen as the winner in a very strong field. Freya was presented with the House Music Cup, now bedecked in yellow ribbons. Well done to all of the students who took part.
