While multiple stud earrings can be worn, no hoop earrings or other facial jewellery are permitted.






## Reminders regarding Jumpers and Jewellery

If you choose to wear a jumper, it must be a V-neck jumper.

For Year 9 and below, this must be green. Years 10 and 11 can wear a black jumper. Sixth Form wear a black V-neck jumper.

No hoodies can be worn under blazers.





## Consequences for incorrect uniform

- You will receive a behaviour point from staff if you are wearing incorrect uniform in the school day
- If you accrue multiple behaviour points, this leads to a detention
- The Senior Team and your Head of Year will be checking behaviour records for uniform.
