Sports Day week and events

Track heats for all year groups are taking place on **Monday 17th July**. These will take place during the following lessons:

Competitors from Years 7 -12 that are competing in the heats should come into school in their PE kit with the option of a t-shirt of their house colour. All non-competing students will attend school in normal uniform.
