Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

Happy New Year! On behalf of the SHSG community, we hope that you enjoyed the Christmas holidays and have returned to school refreshed and ready for the new year ahead.

Please find below information and updates from this week.

### ***Launchpad 'Be a Mathmagician'***

The SHSG Launchpad events are an opportunity for Year 5 students to come into Southend High School for Girls and experience a taster of life at our school. Each event is theme around a faculty in the school; there is always something new and exciting to try out. The 2023-2024 Launchpad events commence on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> January with the Maths faculty and their 'Be a Mathmagician' Launchpad event. This is a jam-packed morning of magical mathematics where the Year 5 pupils learn maths techniques, like those that will be required for the 11+, to create illusions and predictions that defy explanation! There are a limited number of places available for future Launchpads events, however if you know of anyone who might benefit from coming along but may not have heard about the events, more information can be found at the end of this letter. We provide concessions for pupil premium students and find that there is a strong correlation between those Year 5 students who come to the launch pad events and those that end up joining the school at the start of Year 7. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the maths department for giving up their weekend to allow this to happen and to the other faculties who will be putting on similar launchpad events throughout the term.

### ***Uniform reminder***

As we begin the new term, I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents/students of the uniform expectations. Wearing the Southend High School for Girls school uniform correctly and with pride is an important part of our school culture. ### ***Year 11 device use in PPE Revision Lessons***

The return to school from the Christmas break marks the start of the Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) for Year 11 and Year 13 students. I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate both year groups on their conduct and attitude in the first couple of days. These trial exams are a critical part of their preparation toward the real exams in the summer. Within the Year 11 students' examination timetable the students have lessons for focussed silent revision. We have made the decision to allow students to use their personal electronic devices to access the multitude of online revision materials, websites and applications available. It is important to note that staff will be monitoring this privilege during lessons, and should any student be found to be accessing apps and/or content that is not for the purpose of revision they will immediately have this privilege withdrawn.

	<b>13<sup>th</sup> January 2024 - Express Yourself!</b> The Creative and Performing Arts faculty invite you to take part in a morning of creative expression trying your hand at Art, Music, Drama and Technology. The sessions will be active and hands on, giving you the opportunity to explore the full range of creative facilities that we have at SHSG.

### Launchpad - 11+ Familiarisation Sessions

Due to the popularity of these sessions, places are limited and subject to availability. There is an administration fee of £10 per Saturday School session and £30 in total for the four 11+ familiarisation sessions.
