#### Geography globalisation trip

On Tuesday the 29<sup>th</sup> April and Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May, the Geography Department organised a globalisation trip to Southend High Street to understand how the local area has been impacted by globalisation. Students assessed the environmental aspects of the High Street, such as the amount of litter that we could see or how safe they felt in the area. In addition, they conducted several other methods including pedestrian counts, observations, land use mapping and a clone town survey. The afternoons were spent in geography classes where students had to re-design Southend High Street to improve its environment, aesthetics and purpose for Gen-Z, whilst being mindful of costs. Natalie M stated "All the groups presented well and had amazing ideas. However, the winning team showcased their ideas well and I would definitely visit their new High Street! It was a great experience and I have learnt how the High Street has allowed big brands to dominate. However, I feel that High Streets should have a mix of local and big brands making it 'glocalised'."

#### Year 10 Chemistry Revision Sessions - 13th May, 3rd June and 17th June

In order to support Year 10 students with their Chemistry studies as they prepare to enter Year 11, the school has organised revision sessions on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May, Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June and Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June. These focussed sessions will revisit and reinforce several key topics from the GCSE course.

Students in chemistry classes 10Y1, 10Y2 and 10Y3 will attend sessions periods 1-3 on 13<sup>th</sup> May. Sessions for students in chemistry classes 10X1, 10X2 and 10X3 will take place on 3<sup>rd</sup> June periods 1-3.

On 17<sup>th</sup> June the whole cohort will be in the hall for periods 1 and 2 to participate in a 'walking talking mock' led by the chemistry team. The walking talking mock is designed to help learners understand how to approach answering exam questions and support them to interpret the questions. Students have been sent an email informing them of the arrangements. 
